Dear Investor:

The United States government seized monies acquired through a fraud scheme that operated under the name of Kum Ventures Inc. (also known as Kum Holdings). Those monies were recently forfeited to the government. You are receiving this letter because you have been identified as a potential victim of the fraud scheme, making you eligible to submit a Petition for Remission or Mitigation of Forfeiture to the Department of Justice with respect to the seized monies forfeited to the United States.

The United States Attorney for the Central District of California and the Federal Bureau of Investigation have recovered approximately \$1.8 million of the proceeds of the Kum Ventures scheme through a civil forfeiture action. These proceeds will be distributed to eligible victims through a process called "remission." Authority to grant remission rests with the Department of Justice, pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 28, Part 9 (2010).

The Department of Justice has retained BMC Group to assist in reviewing victim remission petitions and distributing the forfeited funds. If you wish to be considered for remission, you must complete the enclosed Petition Form and return it, including copies of all required supporting documentation, to the Remission Administrator. Acceptable supporting documents include cancelled checks, wire transfer records, E-Gold account records and other bank statements indicating a payment into the Kum Ventures scheme.

More detailed instructions for completing the Petition Form are provided elsewhere in this package. You must submit your signed Petition Form on or before **September 18, 2012** to be considered for Remission.
